

# WHO IS MOST LIKELY TO...? A Friendly Competition of Christmas Cheer!



## OBJECTIVE

In this casual Christmas party card game, your group will discover each other's Christmas traditions, gift-giving styles, decorating preferences and more! Whoever accumulates the most cards by the end of the game is the winner.

## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

A total of 48 cards are included in the printable. An additional page of 12 blank cards is available for you to fill in (optional). Print out the card template pages on a thick cardstock and cut out the cards along the dotted lines. For longevity, you can laminate the pages.

Cards can be printed one-sided or two-sided. For one-sided cards, print page 1-5 and trim. For two-sided cards, print pages 1-5, then flip the sheets over and put back in the printer. Print page 6 five times and you're ready to trim.

## HOW TO PLAY

1. Shuffle all of the cards and place the deck face down in the middle of the group.
2. The game will begin with a cardholder drawing a card and reading it aloud to the group. The player whose birthday is closest to Christmas will be the first cardholder.
3. Discuss together who within the group the card best describes.
4. When a consensus is made, give the card to the person who was elected the winner.
5. Person to the left of the cardholder becomes the next cardholder.
6. Continue playing rounds until a player has 7 cards and is declared the winner. (Or if you're still having fun, continue playing until there are no cards remaining.)
